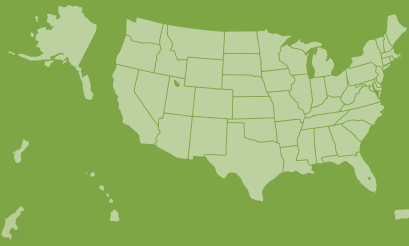


2023 CHILD SUPPORT: MORE MONEY FOR FAMILIES

The Child Support Enforcement Unit handles over 194 active child support cases
