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Uniform Interstate Family Support Act Enforcing an Existing Order in Initiating Cases

An "initiating" case means that the CNMI is asking another state for assistance to either establish a support order or enforce an existing support order. In initiating cases, the custodial parent/guardian (CP) must be residing within the Northern Mariana Islands. The non-custodial parent (NCP) must be residing within the 50 states, U.S. territories, or a foreign reciprocating country. CP must bring in the following documents/information.

REQUIREMENTS:

Custodial Parent:

- Current & prior support orders (including custody, divorce decree, judgment, TRO)
- Photo identification (driver's license or passport)
- Copy of Social Security card (custodial parent & child/ren)
- Residential, mailing, and email address
- Contact number for home, work, and mobile
- Payment history/statement
- Outstanding medical bills not covered by insurance
- Child care expenses

Non-Custodial Parent:

- Photo identification (driver's license or passport)
- Copy of Social Security card or number
- Residential, mailing, and email address
- Contact number for home, work, mobile, and family/friends
- Employer name, address, salary
- Social network (FaceBook, Instagram, Twitter, etc.)
